

ORDINANCE NO. 64
AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PARKING OF
MOTOR VEHICLES IN THE CITY OF GREEN ISLE

The Council of the City of Green Isle, Minnesota, do ordain:

Section 1. Parking Prohibition No vehicle shall be left standing or parked on the following streets in the City of Green Isle between the hours of 2 A. M. and 7 A. M. from November 1st of any year until April 1st of the following year:

1. All streets lying North and South of State Trunk Highway No. 25.

2. All streets lying West of State Trunk Highway No. 5.

Section 2. Motor Vehicles parked or left standing upon City Streets during a snowstorm shall be removed therefrom within two hours after the storm ceases to enable snow removal equipment to clear the streets, or shall be removed immediately upon being notified by the Police Department.

Section 3. The Police Department of this City is hereby authorized to have removed such vehicles from the streets and to store the same for the owner thereof, such removal and storage charges to be paid by the owner of said vehicle.
