

Ordinance No. 16

An Ordinance fixing the license fee for the sale of Intoxicating Liquors, and limiting the number of Saloons.

The Village Council of the Village of Green Isle, Minnesota, do Ordain as follows.

SECTION I.

Any person desiring to sell intoxicating liquors in the Village of Green Isle, in Sibley County, Minnesota shall file with the clerk of said Village a written application, describing the place for which it is desired and the time from which it is to run, and before any such license is issued the applicant therefore shall pay to the Village Treasurer of said Village of Green Isle, the sum of (\$500.00) dollars for said license.

SECTION II.

From and after the passage and due publication of this ordinance the total number of licenses to sell intoxicating liquors within said Village shall not exceed four in number.

SECTION III.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed and of no further force or effect.

SECTION IV.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
