

ARCHERY PARK RULES

1. All archers must sign a waiver. These are available in the Park Mailbox or at the City Office.
2. Any archers under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
3. Arrow Tips – Only arrows tipped with what is commonly referred to as “blunt”, “field point”, “bullet” or “target tips” can be used. Arrows containing broad-head, razor, barbed or explosive are prohibited. All firearms that are not bows/crossbows are prohibited.
4. Shooter – The archer must always stand perpendicular to the approximate center of the target when shooting arrows downrange. Shoot only in the designated area. Do not shoot into the woods or open areas. Shoot only from the designated line.
5. Wait for all archers are finished before going downrange. **NEVER** shoot when someone is downrange.
6. Shoot only at established targets in your lane.
7. Always keep your bow pointed at the target.
8. Always draw your bow with the arrow parallel to the ground.
9. Only nock arrows at the shooting line.
10. Communicate to all if you are searching for an arrow.
11. Be courteous regarding the length of time and number of arrows you shoot.
12. The archery range is drug and alcohol free. All alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
13. Hours of operation are sunrise to sunset.
14. Stay within the boundaries of the range.
15. Retrieve lost arrows quickly. Do not go beyond search area limits.
16. Practice good sportsmanship and common sense.
